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1 Introduction

This document provides the definitions and requirements for files that can be transferred to Clearstream Banking AG via the Investors Portal.

1.1 Format specifications

Files to be uploaded must be in XLS, XLSX (Microsoft Excel©) or CSV (Comma Separated File) format, not exceed 10 MB and have a valid file name.

2 CSV – Format definition

2.1 CSV – General requirements

- Exactly one CSV file with not more than 1,000 lines is submitted per submission.
- The file contains data for one particular account only.
- The field limiter is a semicolon.
- Data is provided in the order of table [2.3](#) CSV – Field definition.
- No column shall be deleted even if no data is available.
- Empty rows and additional columns are not allowed.
- Decimals are defined in the following syntax: 999999999,000
- A comma delimits fractional digits.
- Date fields are in the following ISO format: YYYYMMDD
- Mutated vowels (ä, ö, ü) and special characters, for example ß or &, are not supported and must not be used.
- No header is allowed.
- No footer is allowed.

2.2 CSV – Data row

Example:

[Field 1]; [Field 2]; ...; [Field n]

The number of fields is defined by the instruction type; the number of characters per row is variable.

3 Excel – Format definition

3.1 Excel – General requirements

- Exactly one Excel file is uploaded per submission.
- The Excel file version must be Microsoft Excel 97-2003 (XLS) or Excel Workbook (XLSX).
- The file size is not larger than 10 MB.
- The list contains no more than 1,000 entries. Additional entries are ignored.
- Instruction data starts in row 1.
- One instruction per row.
- Data is aligned with the requirements in table in section [2.3 CSV – Field definition](#). No column shall be deleted even if no data is available.
- No column shall be deleted even if no data is available.
- Empty rows are not allowed within the data set.
- Each file includes data for only one CBF account.
- Date fields are in the following ISO format: YYYYMMDD
- Mutated vowels (ä, ö, ü) and special characters, for example ß or &, are not supported and shall not be used.
- No header is allowed.
- No footer is allowed.

3.2 Excel – Header

The file starts without a header.

3.3 Excel – Data columns

File starts with instruction data in column 1, row 1.

Example:

[Field 1] [Field 2] ... [Field n]

The number of fields is related to the instruction data, the number of characters per row is variable.

3.4 Excel – Field definition

The definitions are the same as for CSV files (See [2.3 CSV - Field definition](#)).

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
