Gerd Hartung joined Deutscher Kassenverein AG (today: Clearstream Banking AG, Frankfurt) in 1996 and is now working as a Senior Vice President in Client Relations Global Securities Financing & Broker/Dealers. He is in charge of outsourcing solutions for cooperation partners around the globe (Liquidity Hub GO) such as the Collateral Management Service launched by CETIP to the Brazilian market in 2011.

During his career at Clearstream Gerd worked in a variety of different roles. In a joint project with Deutsche Bundesbank, he developed a comprehensive Collateral Management Service for the German market which became the backbone of the Euro GC Pooling market jointly set up with Eurex in 2005.

After the merger with Cedel in 2000, he managed a cross location team in Luxembourg, Frankfurt and London being responsible as a Product Manager for all Collateral Services of the new entity Clearstream. In 2004, Gerd was appointed Director and Head of the Market and Business Development of Clearstream.
