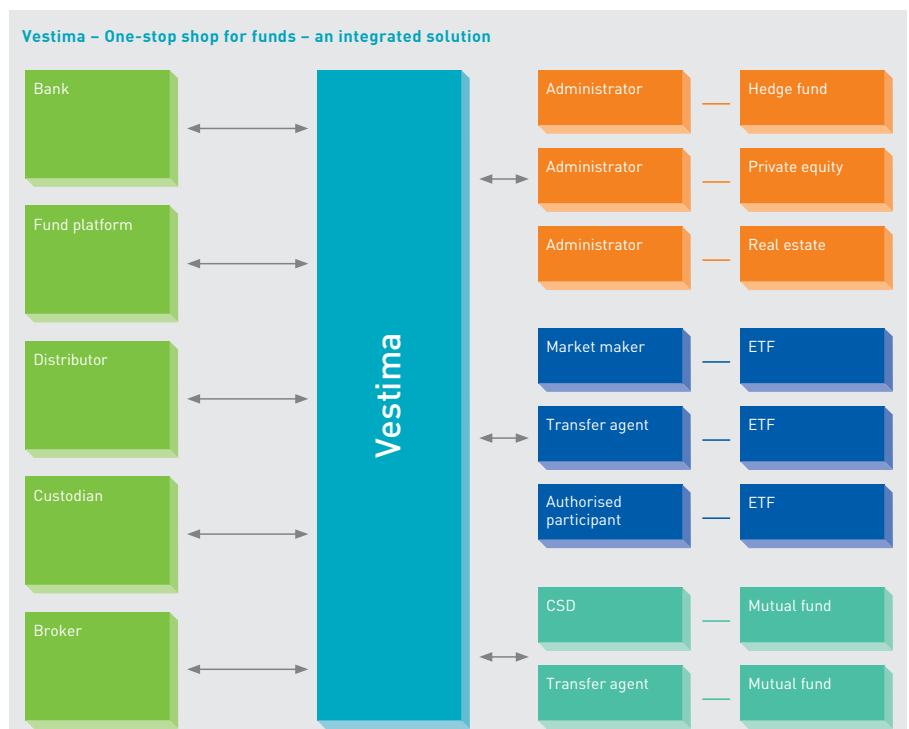
Vestima, the investment fund order routing platform, provides execution and management services from Clearstream Banking, simplifying all aspects of investment funds trading. Optionally linked with Clearstream Banking settlement and custody services, Vestima can provide participants with secure straight-through processing from order input through to automated settlement instructions issuance and final settlement, if required.

Asset safety – Clearstream holds strong, long-term AA ratings from major international rating agencies, which once more reflect Clearstream’s focus on risk management and operational efficiency as well as the strict regulatory framework within which it operates as an ICSD and as Securities Settlement System (SSS).

Highest safety standards – As a global market infrastructure, Clearstream ensures the highest standards of safety for customer assets, including asset segregation and DVP settlement. Clearstream’s interaction with fund agents is contractually regulated and depository banks benefit from reporting on registrars.

Fund Centre is complementing the Vestima One-stop for funds with services in the distribution support space. This range of services provides access to a wide range of funds, distribution agreement commission management, fund research, compliance and regulatory support, as well as enhanced data and documents tools.

Connecting fund providers and distribution partners

Distribution partners using Fund Centre gain access to more than 430 fund providers with a single distribution agreement. Fund Centre's covered investment universe is continuously growing and currently offers over 76,000 products, including funds of the major ETF providers.

Fund Compass

For distribution partners, Fund Compass provides a single point of access for fund documentation including dynamic, static and regulatory data across a wide community of asset managers. It is an intuitive and user-friendly web-based application, supports distribution partners in their analysis and fund selection by providing fund information, fund analytics, fund comparison and added value services. Fund Compass is a modular tool that distribution partners can optimize based on individual needs.

Provider Explorer

The Provider Explorer online application allows asset managers to efficiently and professionally manage the distribution relationship, as well as to access transparent information on distribution partners and their flows and assets developments.

Clarity AI – covering all sustainability aspects of a fund

Clarity AI is an end-to-end technology solution that helps optimize the societal impact of investment portfolios. Clarity AI "scores" the underlying assets of a fund according to its proprietary methodologies and then calculates an aggregated score at share class level. Clarity AI currently offers six modules to cover all sustainability perspectives of an investment fund.

Fund data and Documents

Through Fund Centre, Clearstream offers close to 1,000 data points and all relevant documents, such as prospectuses and KIIDs, on more than 76,000 funds from 25 different jurisdictions and in different languages. Clearstream Fund Centre's fund library is always up to date with static, dynamic and regulatory data thanks to the close and efficient collaboration with fund data providers.

Kneip became part of Deutsche Börse Group in April 2022, operating as a standalone business with the intention of acting as a central fund data hub for Clearstream's Investment Fund Services. From 1st January 2023, Kneip will also become the exclusive provider of data and documents to Clearstream Fund Centre.


Regarding ESG data, Fund Centre offers Fund search functionality based on set of sustainability scores, also allowing comparing share classes. These scores are supported by modules that offer greater amount of depth on sustainable criteria (ESG, Climate, UN SDGs, Regulatory, Exposure).
